2. Delivery Period:

a) Machine must be Delivered and Installation, Testing, Commissioning, Training & Final Acceptance Test (FAT) to be completed within Ten (10) weeks from the date of issue of Contract.

b) The vendor is responsible for delivering the goods and duly unloading the same at the General Store of India Government Mint, Kolkata after taking necessary Gate Pass from CISF at the main gate by showing the ID proof, Purchase Order & invoice etc. and necessary documents like invoice, delivery challan, copy of P O, e-way bill, bank details in company letter head duly sealed and signed etc. are to be handed over to Store-in-charge.

3. Terms and Mode of payments:

(i) 90% on receipt and acceptance of goods by the user section at destination and on production of all required documents by the supplier. (Acceptance means goods supplied in proper condition at India Govt. Mint, Kolkata as well as meeting other terms and conditions of Purchase order.)

(ii) Balance 10% on successful installation & commissioning and issuance of Final Acceptance Certificate (FAC) by India Government Mint, Kolkata.

4. Warranty:

(a) The supplier warrants that the goods supplied under the contract is new, unused and incorporate all recent improvements in design and materials unless prescribed otherwise by India Govt. Mint, Kolkata in the contract. The supplier further warrants that the goods supplied under the contract shall have no defect arising from design, materials (except when the design adopted and / or the material used are as per specification of India Govt. Mint, Kolkata) or workmanship or from any act or omission of the supplier, that may develop under normal use of the supplied goods under the conditions prevailing in India.

(b) The goods along with all accessories supplied & installed under this contract shall be warranted against any type of defects arising due to design, faulty material, workmanship, poor packing and damage during transportation and unloading/shifting/lifting, storage and for trouble free operation.

(c) The Warranty shall remain valid for a period of **One (1) Year** from the date of final acceptance certificate.

ate (FAC) issued by India Government Mint, Kolkata and shall include repairing and replacing of defective parts, workmanship and services, required operational and maintenance support services at free of cost, which are essentially required to put the entire machine in normal operation.

(d) In case of any claim arising out of this warranty, India Govt. Mint shall promptly notify the same in writing to the supplier.

(e) Upon receipt of such notice, the supplier shall, with all reasonable speed and time, repair or replace the defective goods free of cost, at the ultimate destination. The supplier shall take over the replaced goods after providing their replacements and no claim, whatsoever shall lie on India Govt. Mint, Kolkata for such replaced goods thereafter.

(f) In the event of any rectification of a defect or replacement of any defective goods during the warranty period, the warranty for the rectified/ replaced goods shall be extended to a further period of twelve months from the date such rectified / replaced goods starts functioning to the satisfaction of India Govt. (g) If the supplier, having been notified, fails to rectify/ replace the defect(s) within a delivery period, India Govt. 16. Qualification/ Eligibility Criteria

A. EXPERIENCE & PAST PERFORMANCE:

The bidder (manufacturer or principal of authorized representative - hereinafter referred simply as 'The Bidder') shall be a manufacturer that has regularly for at least the last three years manufactured, supplied, erected, commissioned "Potentiometric Auto Titrator" with the same or higher specifications of at least One (1) number in last five years ending on 31.03.2023. At least one number of the product offered for supply should be in successful operation for at least one year on the date of bid opening.

Note:

B. CAPABILITY - EQUIPMENT & MANUFACTURING FACILITIES:

The bidder must have an annual capacity to manufacture and supply at least One (1) number "Potentiometric Auto Titrator".

C. FINANCIAL STANDING:

17. MSME & Make in India Status:

18. Price Preference for MSE:

19. Eligible Goods and Services (Origin of Goods & Services):

(ii) The word "origin" incorporated in this clause means the place from where the goods are mined, cultivated, grown, manufactured, produced or processed or from where the goods & service are arranged.
