- 1. Special terms and conditions-Version:2 effective from 11-12-2023 for category Split Air Conditioner Including Green AC, Wall Mount Type

1. STC FOR SPLIT AIR CONDITIONER

Central Ministries/ Departments while procuring electrical appliances notified by the Department of Expenditure (DoE) shall ensure that they carry the notified threshold or higher Star Rating of the Bureau of Energy Efficiency (BEE). In this regard, DoE OM No.26/6/2012-PPD dated 21.01.2013 may also be referred to wherein appliances and threshold star ratings have been circulated.

Scope of installation and Commissioning for Wall Mount / High wall Split AC

- (1) Mounting/Fitting of indoor and outdoor units at the respective locations.
- (2) Laying of refrigerant piping and connecting with indoor and outdoor units after drilling hole/holes in the wall (all type of walls), if required.
- (3) Checking / Charging Refrigerant gas in the unit.
- (4) Suitable electric wiring between indoor units and switch upto 3 meters in length.
- (5) Testing for satisfactory working without any abnormal noise as well as leakage test of the entire system.

The following are not included in the scope of supply for Wall Mount / High wall Split AC

- (1) Chiselling / Ducting / grooving for concealing the Refrigerant piping/cabling
- (2) Switches/ Sockets / Plug Tops / Voltage Stabilizer/Stand for ODU/Drain pipe/Angles.

Note to Buyer: Buyer are advised to apply filters/ selections allowing all the values which are considered meeting or are better than their technical requirements e.g. if the requirement is 5 years compressor warranty; Buyer should select other superior values, i.e. 10years warranty as well. Such selection will act as 5 years or better (in L1 buying). For any violation of the above advisory if resulting into limited competition or higher cost to the ex-chequer, the Buyer shall be solely responsible.

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.

2. Certificates

Bidder's offer is liable to be rejected if they don't upload any of the certificates / documents sought in the Bid document, ATC and Corrigendum if any.

3. Delivery Period:

- a) The bidder is required to deliver & install the items within Thirty (30) Days from the date of issue of Contract.
- b) The supplier is responsible for delivering the items and duly unloading the same at the Concerned Depar tment of India Government Mint, Kolkata after taking necessary security clearance from CISF at the main g ate of India Government Mint, Kolkata by showing the driving licence, vehicle registration etc. and necessary documents like invoice, delivery challan, copy of Purchase Order, e-way bill, bank details in company let ter head duly sealed & signed etc. are to be handed over to Store- in- charge.

4. Terms and Mode of payments:

100% on receipt and acceptance of goods at destination by the user section of India Government Mint, Kol kata and on production of all required documents by the supplier. (Acceptance means goods supplied in proper condition at India Govt. Mint, Kolkata as well as meeting other terms and conditions of Purchase order.)

5. Replacement:

If the items delivered are rejected for any reasons, the firm has to lift & replace the same at their cost and risk.

6. Transportation of Domestic Goods:

To be borne by the supplier duly unloaded at the General store of India Govt. Mint, Kolkata.

7. Packing:

Items should be suitably packed. The packing should be weather proof and should be made water proof to prevent damage during transit. The supplier will also be responsible for unloading and stacking at India Go vernment Mint, Kolkata Store as per instruction of competent authority.

8. Insurance:

The supplier shall make arrangements for insuring the goods and services against loss or damage, inciden tal to manufacture or acquisition, transportation, storage and delivery. The Supplier shall be responsible til I the entire goods contracted for arrive in good condition at destination. The transit risk in this respect shal I be covered by the supplier by getting the goods duly insured. The insurance cover shall be obtained by the supplier in its own name not in the name of India Government Mint, Kolkata or its consignee. For details please refer to clause 12 of General Conditions of Contract (GCC).

9. Quantum of LD:

If the supplier fails to deliver any or all of the goods or fails to perform the services within the time frame(s) incorporated in the contract, India Govt. Mint, Kolkata shall, without prejudice to other rights and remedi es available to India Govt. Mint, Kolkata under the contract, deduct from the contract price, as liquidated d amages, a sum equivalent to the 0.5% of the delivered price of the delayed goods and/ or services for each week of delay or part thereof until actual delivery or performance, subject to a maximum deduction of the 10% of the delayed goods' or services' contract price(s).

- **10.** The total cost inclusive of all as cited above on FOR India Govt. Mint, Kolkata (W.B) basis should be ind icated clearly both in words and figures in the price bid.
- 11. Documentary evidence to be submitted towards PAN & GST Registration Certificate.

- **12.** Participating Bidder must submit sealed and signed copy of entire GeM bid document including the Tec hnical Specification. Also the participating bidder must submit sealed & signed Annexure I in their letter he ad & checklist attached at the end of this bid.
- **13.** All the supporting documents submitted along with this bid should be signed and sealed by the author ized signatory of the firm mandatorily. The bid document shall not contain any erasure or overwriting, exc ept as necessary to correct any error made by the tenderer and, if there is any such correction; the same s hall be initialled by the person(s) signing the tender.
- 14. The supplier has to provide GeM invoice during submission of bill for payment.

15. Price Schedule:

While quoting the price through GeM portal, the detailed price breakup along with GST percen tage must be mentioned and attached as pdf in the document attachment option of price bid mandatorily. Do not upload financial documents related to financial standings like audited balance sheets in the document attachment field of price bid, attach only the detailed price breakup of the quotation as m entioned above.

Price to be mentioned only in price bid not in Techno commercial bid or any other place. If it is mentioned any other part other than price bid, the offer will be rejected.

16. MSME & Make in India Status:

In case any bidder is submitting their bid as MSME and/or MII, the firm must be registered as a MSME & MII in GeM portal and Self-declaration along with documentary evidence in this regard must be submitted declaring that their MSME & MII status is updated in GeM portal also. In further evaluation stage if it is found that the firm is not registered as MSME and/or MII in GeM, but MSME certificate and/or MII declaration is submitted along with the bid, no exemption will be given and their offer may be rejected.

17. Price Preference for MSE:

MSE quoting price within price band L1 \pm 15% may be awarded 25% of the total tendered value provided t hey agree to match the L1 price. In case of more than one such eligible MSE, 25% quantity is to be distributed proportionately among these bidders. Within this, a purchase preference of 4% is reserved for MSEs owned by SC/ST entrepreneurs' and 3% is reserved for procurement from MSEs owned by women (if they participate in the tender process and match the L1 price, considering spirit of policy for enhancing the Govt. procurement from MSE.

18. Eligible Goods and Services (Origin of Goods & Services):

- (i) All goods and services to be supplied and provided for the contract shall have the origin in India or in the countries with which the Government of India has trade relations.
- (ii) The word "origin" incorporated in this clause means the place from where the goods are mines, cultivat ed, grown, manufactured, produced or processed or from where the service are arranged.
- **19. Special Condition:** Supplier should file the returns pertaining to TCS (Section 206C (1H) for TCS colle cted, in the time and provide the TCS certificate to IGMK. In case of any Credit loss to IGMK by way of their failure to files Returns and provide TCS certificate in time, India Government Mint, Kolkata reserves the rig ht to recover the amount equivalent to TCS paid along with applicable interest from the payment of further supplies.

20. GST Return:

Supplier should file the GST return for outward supplies in time. 22. Resolution of Disputes:

If dispute or difference of any kind shall arise between India Government Mint, Kolkata and the supplier in connection with or relating the contract, the parties shall make every effort to resolve the same amicably by mutual consultations. If the parties fail to resolve their dispute or difference by such mutual consultation within 21 days of its occurrence, then, depending on the position of the case, either the purchaser or the supplier shall give notice to the other party of its intention to commence arbitration. When the contract is with domestic supplier, the applicable arbitration procedure will be as per Indian Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 as amended by Arbitration and Conciliation (Amendment) Act, 2015 and 2021. Mode of settlement of such contractual disputes/ differences shall be through Arbitration, to the India International Arbitration Centre.

23. Risk Purchase Clause:

- (a) If the supplier after submission of tender and due acceptance of the same, i.e. after notification of awar d of contract fails to abide by the terms and conditions of these tender documents, or fails to supply the de liverables as per delivery schedule given or at any time repudiates the contract, the purchaser shall have t he right to:
