2. Delivery Period:

- a) The bidder is required to deliver the Machine including Pre-Dispatch Inspection(PDI), if any, within Seve nty Two (72) weeks from the date of issue of contract.
- b) Installation, Commissioning, Testing, Training and Final Acceptance Test (FAT) to be Completed within S eventy Six (76) Weeks from the date of issue of Contract.
- c) The supplier is responsible for delivering the Machine and duly unloading the same at the Rolling-Cutting Department of India Government Mint, Kolkata after taking necessary security clearance from CISF at the main gate of India Government Mint, Kolkata by showing the driving licence, vehicle registration etc. and n ecessary documents like invoice, delivery challan, copy of Purchase Order, e-way bill, bank details in comp any letter head duly sealed & signed etc. are to be handed over to Store- in- charge.

3. Terms and Mode of payments:

100% payment will be made after issuance of Final Acceptance Certificate (FAC) by India Government Mint . Kolkata.

4. Warranty:

- (a) The machine along with all accessories supplied & installed under this contract shall be warranted agai nst any type of defects arising due to design, faulty material, workmanship, poor packing and damage during transportation and unloading/shifting/lifting, storage and for trouble free operation.
- (b) The Warranty shall remain valid for a period of **Twelve (12) months** from the date of final acceptance certificate (FAC) issued by India Government Mint, Kolkata and shall include repairing and replacing of def ective parts, workmanship and services, required operational and maintenance support services at free of cost, which are essentially required to put the entire machine in normal operation.
- (c) The firm will have to give written undertakings that the goods supplied under this contract are new, of the recent models and incorporate all recent improvements in design and materials unless provided other wise in the contract.
- (d) The bidder shall ensure that OEM/Manufacturers of machine/material offered under this contract shall s upport the equipment at least for a period of 10 years from the date of FAC.
- (e) In case of any claim arising out of this warranty, India Govt. Mint shall promptly notify the same in writing to the supplier. Upon receipt of such notice, the supplier shall within a period of maximum 10 days to repair or replace the defective goods or services or part thereof at the ultimate destination without any cost to India Government Mint, Kolkata.

A. EXPERIENCE & PAST PERFORMANCE:

The bidder (manufacturer or principal of authorized representative - hereinafter referred simply as 'The Bid der') shall be a manufacturer that has regularly for at least the last three years manufactured, supplied, er ected, commissioned "2 Hi Break Down and 4 Hi Finishing - Combine Rolling Mill' with the same or higher specifications of at least One(1) number in last five years ending on 31.03.2023. At least one numb er of the product offered for supply should be in successful operation for at least one year on the date of bid opening.

Note:

B. CAPABILITY - EQUIPMENT & MANUFACTURING FACILITIES:

The bidder must have an annual capacity to manufacture and supply at least One (1) number "2 Hi Break Down and 4 Hi Finishing - Combine Rolling Mill".

Note:

- (i) In support of the Capability, the bidder has to submit copy of supporting documents i.e. details of equip ment and manufacturing facilities, engineers/managers details, number of skilled labors available with the firm, Copy of Purchase Order/Supply/Work Order; respective completion certificate, SOP of the manufacturing process, Quality control systems, annual capacity etc.
- (ii) For verifying the Capability/Capacity, India Government Mint, Kolkata reserves the right to depute its a uthorised representatives at the worksites of the bidder. In the event, the firm is found not having capabilit y/capacity, their offer is liable to be rejected.

C. FINANCIAL STANDING:

- 1) The average annual financial turnover of the bidder firm (manufacturer or principal of authorized dealer) during the last three years, ending on 31.03.2023, should be at least **Rs.7.24 Crore** as per the annual rep ort (audited balance sheet and profit & loss account) of the relevant period, duly authenticated by a Chart ered Accountant/Cost Accountant in India.
- 2) The net worth of the Bidder should
- a) not be negative on 31.03.2023 and
- b) not have eroded by more than 30% in the last three years, ending on 31.03.2023.

Note:

- (i) For net worth erosion calculation of last three(3) years ending on 31.03.2023, audited balance sheet of f inancial years i.e: 2020-21, 2021-22 & 2022-23 must be submitted.
- (ii) Supporting documents to be furnished as claim against the above Financial Standing: all financial standing data should be certified by certified accountants.
- (iii) Non-submission or incomplete submission of documents may lead to rejection of offer.
- (iv) For MSEs and Start-ups (registered for the tendered item) all financial criteria shall be exempted.

- 2. Price to be mentioned only in price bid not in Techno commercial bid or any other place. If it is mentioned any other part other than price bid, the offer will be rejected.
