3. Terms and Mode of payments:

Nature of service:

Fogging and larvicidal treatment services for treatment for prevention of Mosquitoes, flying insects etc. inside the entire Mint premises covering factory area, admin building, medical, CISF barrack, Old CMO Bungalow, General Store, RBI Vault, Garage, other open space behind Mint factory, lawns, etc.

Terms & Conditions:

- 1. The frequency of the service will be twice in a month or as and when required basis for General/Integrated Pest Control and for Mosquito Control Treatment; service will be as and when required as directed by the Mint. Special Conditions of Contracts:

- 2. All employees of contractor must be trained and well aware of the effects of these Chemical at the time of using/handling/storing. Anti-dot of any chemical must be kept ready with contractor/authorized person for emergency use of un-expired date.
